Priesthood of the Believer

Type of Priesthood of Jesus (Melchizedekian - i.e. "King-Priest")

Psa 110:4⁴ The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

Heb 7:1-3 ¹ For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; (Gen 14:18-20) ² To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace; ³ Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but <u>made like unto</u> the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

Heb 7:14-17 ¹⁴ For *it is* evident that our Lord sprang out of Juda; of which tribe Moses spake nothing concerning priesthood. ¹⁵ And it is yet far more evident: for that <u>after the similitude of Melchisedec</u> there ariseth another priest, ¹⁶ Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. ¹⁷ For he testifieth, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Jesus' Priesthood is Pictured in Zechariah with two men who together laid the foundation of the 2nd temple

1. **Zerubbabel** – from the tribe of Judah (the kingly tribe) who is part of a priestly service vision:

Zec 4:1-3 ¹ And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep, ² And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof: ³ And two olive trees by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.

Zec 4:5-9 ⁵ Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord. ⁶ Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts. ⁷ Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it. ⁸ Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, ⁹ The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you.

2. Joshua the High Priest (The priestly tribe) who's given kingly crowns:

Zec 6:9-13 ⁹ And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, ¹⁰ Take of *them of* the captivity, *even* of Heldai, of Tobijah, and of Jedaiah, which are come from Babylon, and come thou the same day, and go into the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah; ¹¹ Then take silver and gold, and **make crowns, and set** *them* **upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest;** ¹² And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, **Behold the man whose name** *is* **The BRANCH** ("Jesus" cf. Zec 3:8; Jer 23:5-6, Jer 33:15-16); and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD: ¹³ Even he shall build the temple of the LORD; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Type of Priesthood of the Believer: Same as Jesus (Melchizedekian – i.e. "King-Priest")

Rom 8:16-17 ¹⁶ The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: ¹⁷ And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Thus:

Rev 1:5-6 ⁵ And from Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, ⁶ <u>And hath</u> <u>made us kings and priests</u> unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Rev 5:10 ¹⁰ And hast made us unto our <u>God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth</u>.

Rev 20:6 ⁶ Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be **priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.**

Our Priesthood is demonstrated in 3 ways: Our Praises, Our Prayers, Our Person

1. Praises

1 Pet 2:5 ⁵ Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

Hos 14:2 ² Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips

Heb 13:15 ¹⁵ By him therefore let us offer <u>the sacrifice of praise</u> to God continually, that is, <u>the fruit of our lips</u> giving thanks to his name.

Psa 107:21-22 ²¹ Oh that *men* would praise the LORD *for* his goodness, and *for* his wonderful works to the children of men! ²² And **let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving**, and declare his works with rejoicing.

Psa 50:23 ²³ Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth *his* conversation *aright* will I shew the salvation of God.

2. Prayers

Rev 5:8 ⁸ And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four *and* twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints

Rev 8:2-4 ² And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets. ³ And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. ⁴ And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.

3. Person

Rom 12:1 ¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye **present your bodies a living** sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

1 Pet 2:9 ⁹ But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Cf. Mt 5:13 Let your light shine...that they might see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
